# Extra help

Each year we encourage parents to apply for **Pupil Premium** support. Doing so brings additional funds into school to support your child. There is no stigma attached to applying for this funding and other families will not be aware that you have done so.

The additional money that comes into school for eligible pupils can be used to pay for day and residential trips, school clubs as well as fund school uniform. It could also very likely enable your child to have 1:1 tuition at school. #### A gift for the whole class...


