This important event will coincide with the 'Oadby Lights switch on' and run from 10.30am until 3.30pm.

On **Sunday 11th November** the exhibition will also run from 11.30am to 4.30pm to coincide with the service of remembrance in St Peter's Church which begins at 10.00am.

It would be great for our families to visit this special exhibition in St Peters hall (opposite the church) and remember those who have fought & died for their country in the Great War.
